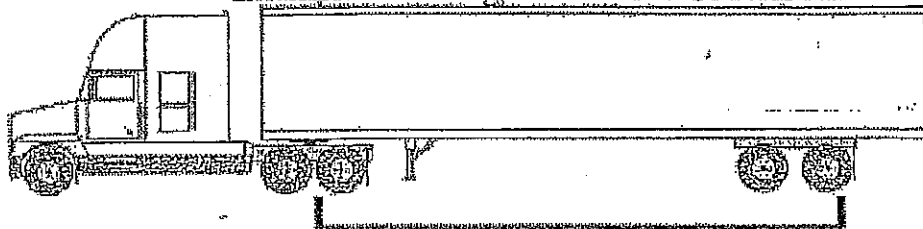

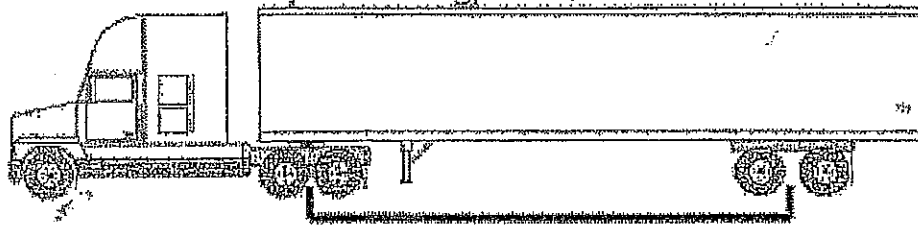
Measurements for 53 FT Trailer Bridge Restrictions

Example "A" Kingpin to Center Of Rear Axle



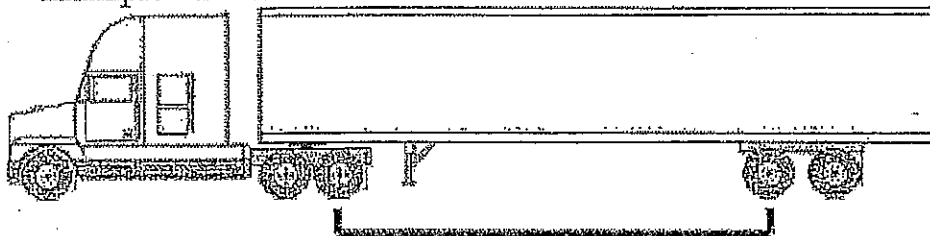

Example "B" Kingpin to Center of Rear Tandem



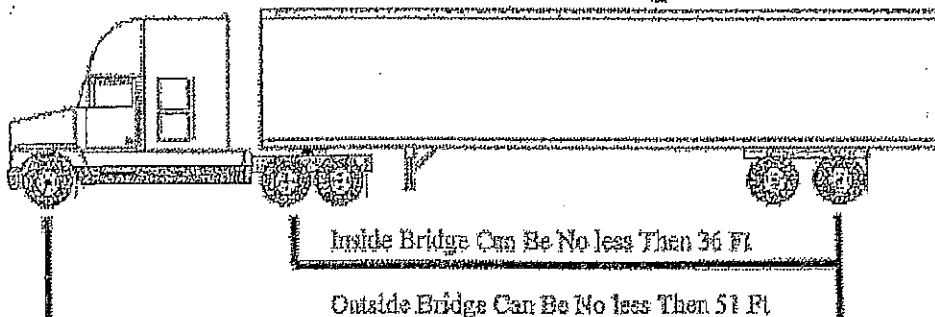

*****HOW TO FIGURE TRANSIT TIME*****

TEAM TRANSIT IS 50MPH. SOLO TRANSIT IS 28 MPH.

To get the amount of time it will take to run a load, take the miles, & divide it by 50 (or 28 mph for solo transit) Example - 1568 miles divided by 50 mph would take 31 hours & 36 minutes. (so round up to 32 hours)

To figure arrival time based on transit-

(Remember, do this in 1/4 hour increments, and it is .00/.25/.50/.75)

Use military time when doing this.

So if the current time is 12:35, you would round up to 12:45, and on your calculator, this would be 12.75

Take the miles & divide by 50 mph. Then add the current time. Then subtract 1,2, or 3 hours if you are travelling west, and delivering to a different time zone. Then subtract in increments of 24 until the time showing on your calculator is less than 24. The number of times you subtracted 24 equals 1 day per each 24 hour increment.

EXAMPLE-a trip from Salisbury, NC to Colton, CA would be as follows.

2383 loaded miles. Divided by 50 mph = 47.66, so round up to 48 hours.

Let's say you are departing the shipper at 1530 (3:30pm) Add the time to 48 hours. This gives you 63.16. Then subtract 3 for the time difference. This gives you 60.16. Now subtract 24 from that number until you get under 24. This gives you 12.16. You had to subtract 24 twice, so that is 2 days. So, if you departed NC at 1530 on Wed, your eta would be 1230 on Fri.
